Afghanistan U-19 Beat Bangladesh to Level ODI Series

KABUL - Afghanistan Under-19 defeated Bangladesh in their third One-day International (ODI) match on Monday, a board official said. Afghanistan Cricket Board (ACB) spokesman, Farid Hottak, told Pajhwok Afghan News that the Afghanistan U-19 won the toss and asked Bangladesh to bat first. The Bangladeshis posted a meagre total of 75 runs in the 50 overs match at the Sylhet International Cricket Stadium. For Afghanistan, Nawin Alhaq claimed four wickets, Tariq Stanikzai two and Yousuf Zazai, Mujib Zadran and Esmatullah grabbed one scalp each. Hottak said Afghanistan raced to the target in the 18th over for the loss five wickets. Nawin Alhaq was announced as man of the match. The first one-day was won by Bangladesh while the second was washed out. (Pajhwok)



9 Members of Special Militia Unit Killed in Friendly Fire

LASHKARGAH - Nine Afghan security personnel have been killed and a dozen more wounded in an airstrike by in southern Helmand province, officials confirmed on Monday. Omar Zwak, the governor's spokesman, told Pajhwok Afghan News a security checkpoint in the Adam Khan area of Greshk district came under mistaken attack late on Sunday. Nine soldiers were killed and 12 others wounded in the bombing, according to the official, who had no information whether NATO troops or the Afghan Air Force (AAF) conducted the raid. Efforts on to Ensure Safe Flow of Traffic on Salang Highway

KABUL - Efforts have been made for safe and secure flow of traffic through the Salang Pass during winter, authorities concerned told lawmakers on Monday. Abdul Rahman Salahi, secretary at Ministry of Public Works, Mohammad Aslam Sayas, secretary and acting state minister for disaster management and Gen. Rajab, head of the Salang Pass Protection and Safety Authority were summoned by the Wolesi Jirga who briefed the lawmakers about future plan and strategies. Salahi told lawmaker that Salang remained opened throughout the year, but a large number of traffic and movement of heavy vehicles damaged the vital Highway. He added: "For basic reconstruction work of the highway there is a need for

2 Dead in Faryab Clinic Explosion

MAIMANA - Two people were killed and one wounded in a bomb blast inside a clinic in the Khwaja Sabzposh district of northwestern Faryab province on Monday morning. Abdullah Masoomi, the district's administrative chief, told Pajhwok Afghan News the incident took place at a health centre at 9am. He said a woman and one man were killed and a nurse wounded. He added no one had been arrested in connection with the blast. Police have launched an investigation into the incident. A resident of the area, who did not want to be named, said four injured ... Enraged Khost Protestors Want Police Chief Sacked

KHOST CITY - Hundreds of protestors in Dwamanda district of southeastern Khost province on Monday asked the Ministry of Interior (MoI) to dismiss the provincial police chief and the crime-branch head for incompetency and demanded their referral to attorney's office. The protestors numbering in hundreds blocked the Kabul-Khost Highway for traffic for almost four hours in Borgai area of the district. They alleged the Police Chief Brig. Gen. Dozens of Militants Killed in Uruzgan Offensive

TIRINKOT - At least 30 Taliban insurgents have been killed and 15 others wounded in an ongoing operation in central Uruzgan province, an official said on Monday. Police chief Brig. Gen. Rahmatullah Siddiqi told Pajhwok Afghan New Taliban's attacks in Chora district were repulsed and a clearing operation was underway. Gen. Siddiqi said 30 militants, including some notorious commanders, were killed and 15 others wounded during the air-and-ground offensives in Niaz and Kalaragh areas late on Sunday night. 
